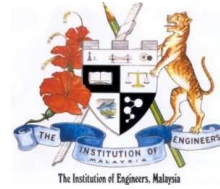

Associate Professor Ir Hayati Abdullah joined the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering (FKM), Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (UTM) in 1986 and was later attached to the Faculty of Chemical Engineering and Natural Resources in 1990. She was seconded to the Malaysian Armed Forces Academy (now Universiti Pertahanan Malaysia) in 1995 for 3 years as Head of Mechanical Engineering Department and Deputy Director (Academics). She then came back to FKM, UTM assuming the position of an Associate Professor. Ir. Hayati is currently the Director for UTM's Professional Qualification Development Programme.

Specializing in Thermodynamics further enhances her position as a resource person in the area of Thermodynamics and Energy Management in UTM. She is a consultant for the Centre For Energy Studies, Sultan Iskandar Institute of Urban Habitat and Highrise, Universiti Teknologi Malaysia and has more than 20 years of energy auditing experience in industries and commercial buildings. She has carried out extensive research in the area of air-conditioning and has recently filed the grant of a patent with MyIPO together with her research group in respect of an invention entitled a control system and methods of maintaining temperature thereof. Her current research work is focused on green refrigerant for building air-conditioning systems. Ir. Hayati is a Professional Engineer registered with the Board of Engineers Malaysia. She is also a Chartered Engineer registered with The Engineering Council United Kingdom. Ir. Hayati is a Chartered Marine Engineer and a Fellow of The Institute of Marine Engineering, Science and Technology, United Kingdom, a Fellow of The Institution of Engineers Malaysia and a Member of The Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers, USA. She is also a member of the Energy Professional Association of Malaysia (MEPA). Ir. Hayati is the first lady engineer to hold the position of the Honorary Treasurer of The Institution of Engineers Malaysia (Southern Branch) and has held this position since session 2008/2009 till present. 26 years of direct collaboration to churn Mechanical Engineers as effective industry players has heighten Ir. Hayati Abdullah's competency in delivering quality education to the young Malaysians aspiring to become Mechanical Engineers. Ir. Hayati parted her knowledge to a diverse spectrum of full-time undergraduate and post-graduate engineering students. She also taught professional courses to engineers in various industries hence supporting the life-long learning initiative. Her ability to interconnect her knowledge and experience acquired through teaching, research, consultancy and professional development programmes, has contributed to developing her own innovative teaching style emphasizing the achievements of learning outcomes. Believing in the teaching philosophy of involving students, she passionately practices active and cooperative-based learning to allow her students to expand their learning sphere beyond classroom education. She successfully pioneered the Content-Area Tutoring (CAT) programme in UTM and initiated the use of the 'Developmental Model' approach for academic advising in UTM. Ir. Hayati is also the founder of the Young Women Engineer Section of the UTM-IEM student Chapter. Ir. Hayati Abdullah is the first recipient of UTM's Excellence in Teaching Award (Anugerah Pengajar Terbaik) in 2005 and also the first recipient of UTM's Excellence in Academic Advising Award (Anugerah Penasihat Akademik Terbaik) in 2008. As the first recipient from UTM to have the honour of receiving the prestigious national award 'Anugerah Akademik Negara - Pengajaran Kejuruteraan' in 2010, Ir. Hayati will continue her commitment to quality teaching in her endeavor to help produce the necessary professionals for tomorrow.

She first headed the Business Development unit in 2003, later as the General Manager of ILSAS in 2005, before becoming the Managing Director of TNB Integrated Learning Solution a wholly owned subsidiary of TNB in 2008. Before 2008, ILSAS stands for Institut Latihan Sultan Ahmad Shah, and in 2008, ILSAS is TNB Integrated Learning Solution. "ILSAS" is still kept as the brand name for TNB Training Institute
