Turnaround work scope serves as the foundation for plant reliability, cost, and schedule. The main driver influencing competitiveness is minimizing the amount of scope and scope expansion throughout turnaround execution.

Scope management is an essential function which influence the degree of turnaround project success. Therefore, a turnaround's cost, timeliness and quality are all directly impacted by a scope management process failure or uncertainty.

The speaker will share methodology and best practices in identification, selection, monitoring and control of scope during all phases of initiation, planning, execution and closure turnaround management to have improved performance. The methodology and practices may be **applied to most of the projects** across industries.
